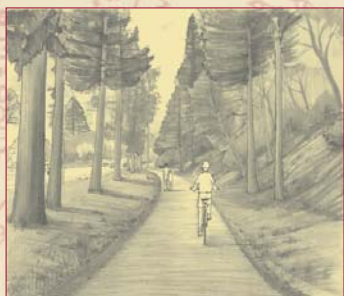

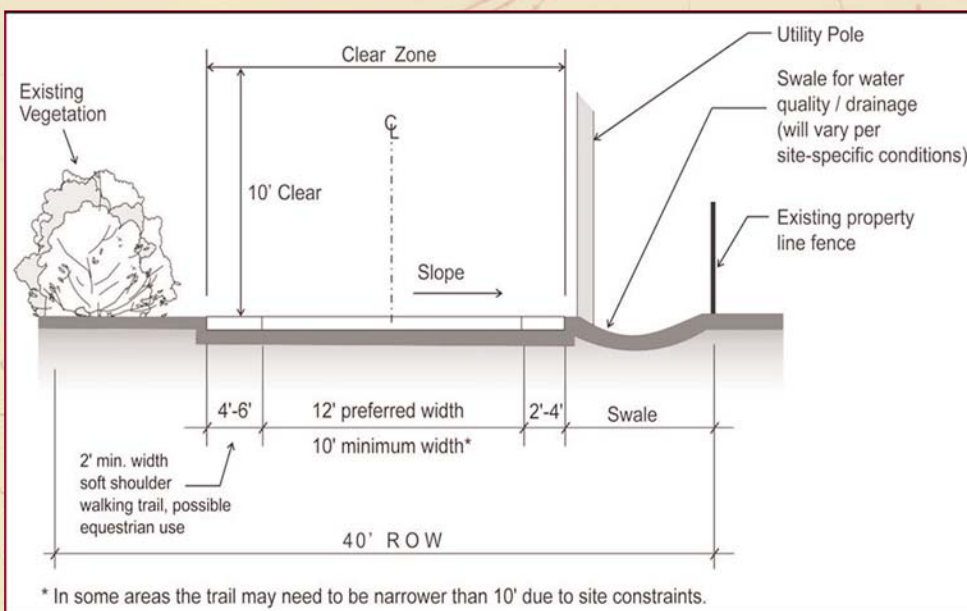
N CPRD: Trolley Trail expected to begin construction in late August

The long-awaited Trolley Trail, stretching about 6 miles from Milwaukie to Gladstone on the eastern side of the Willamette River, will begin construction in late summer 2010.

Here are a few highlights:

- Between now and April, some trees and vegetation will be removed from the trail property in anticipation of construction. Removal now avoids any conflicts with nesting and migrating birds during the start of construction season. Many of the plants being removed are invasive or pose a safety hazard to trail users (ie., falling limbs or proximity to the trail). Existing concrete barriers will be removed for a few weeks while this work is being completed.
- General contractor for the project should be selected by public bid in late July, with significant work beginning in the fall.
- Construction should last about nine months with conclusion of the project in summer 2011.
- Due to future light rail development between Portland and Oak Grove, Tri-Met is building the portion of the trail from River Road to Park Avenue south of Milwaukie at a later date.
- During construction, N CPRD will try to be in contact with the community as the need arises, but to keep in line with weather and contractual obligations, neighbors and area business owners won't always receive a personal update. Concerned citizens' reports from the trail are of course appreciated.
- Be mindful of construction - well-intended interruptions will slow down the work and drive up costs. Although anticipation for the trail's completion is great, access to the construction site will be limited for reasons of safety, liability and security.
